Y Cardi Bach Bus

The Cardi Bach is an all-year round bus service connecting towns and villages between Cardigan and New Quay. Walkers can take a 'one-way' journey on the bus and return along the Ceredigion Coast Path. You can also use the Cardi Bach to explore the spectacular scenery of Cardigan Bay – beaches and picturesque sea-side villages and a wealth of wildlife await you. Looking out to sea, you may even catch a glimpse of a bottlenose dolphin.

Pellter: 1.7 milltir (2.7 cilomedr) Gradd: cymedrol
Distance: 1.7 miles (2.7 km) Grade: moderate

Pellter: 3.2 milltir (5.1 cilomedr) Gradd: anodd
Distance: 3.2 miles (5.1 km) Grade: hard

Y Llwybr

Mae Llwybr Arfordir Ceredigion yn dilyn trywydd 60 millir / 96 cilomedr o hyd rhwng aberoedd Teifi a Dyfi gan ddechrau i'r de o dref hanesyddol Aberteifi ac yn ymlwbro i'r gogledd i draeth Ynyslas. Mae'r llwybr yn cysylltu trefi a phentrefi ar hyd arfordir trawiadol Bae Ceredigion.

Mae'r daith ar hyd bwa Bae Ceredigion yn ffurfio rhan arbennig iawn o Lwybr Arfordir Cymru. Mae'r rhan trwy Geredigion gyda'r tirwedd mwyaf amrywiol a gwahanol o'r 870 milltir (1400km) sy'n ffurfio Llwybr Arfordir Cymru. Yn ogystal â'r golygfeydd gorau o Eryri a Llŷn i'r gogledd, mae cyfoeth o fywyd gwylt a chynefinoedd, gan gynnwys y nifer uchaf o ddolffiniaid trwynbwl unrhywle yn y Deyrnas Unedig, ac mae nodweddion daearegol ac archaeolegol amrwylol i'w darganfod ar y ffordd.

Daw hanes diddorol yr ardal i'r amlwg ar hyd y daith o fryngaerau'r Oes Haearn ac ogofau ysmuglwyr i harbyrau'r 19fed ganrif. Dynodwyd pedwar rhan o'r arfordir yn Arfordir Treftadaeth, a cheir dwy Ardal Cadwraeth Arbennig Morol oherwydd pwysigrwydd bywyd gwylt y bae.

Gellir cerdded y 60 milltir ar hyd Bae Ceredigion mewn darnau hwylus gyda siopau, caffis, tafarndai a bwytai mewn trefi lliwgar byrlymus a phentrefi tlws yn cynnig cyfle am hoe ar hyd y daith.

The Ceredigion Coast Path

“ There is to Ceredigion
A coastline full of passion
That reaches out across the Bay

The Path

The Ceredigion Coast Path follows a 60 mile / 96 km route between the Teifi and Dyfi estuaries – starting just south of Cardigan and heading northwards towards Ynyslas. The coast path links towns and villages dotted along the spectacular Ceredigion coastline.

The walk along the sweeping crescent of Cardigan Bay forms a very special part of the Wales Coast Path. The Ceredigion section probably has the most varied landscape and terrain of the 870 mile (1400km) length of the Wales Coast Path. As well as great views north towards Snowdonia, the Ceredigion Coast Path has a wealth of wildlife and habitats, including the highest number of bottlenose dolphin sightings in the UK, and interesting geological and archaeological features to discover along the way. The area's rich seafaring history is much in evidence from iron-age hillforts and secluded smugglers' coves to 19th century harbours. Four sections of the coastline are designated as Heritage Coast whilst two areas within Cardigan Bay are Marine Special Areas of Conservation in recognition of the importance of their wildlife.

The 60 mile route along Cardigan Bay can be walked in easy sections with shops, cafes, pubs and restaurants in bustling towns and picturesque villages providing a welcome break en-route.
